For the 2017-18 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school has not been given one of these labels.

North Central Academy has made significant advancement in its standardized test scores over the last several years. This achievement can be attributed to staff teaching methodology, improved school culture and enhanced discipline procedures. One of our challenges has been the high turnover rate of staff. We have been implementing strategies to retain powerful, highly competent staff.
